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

BAB I

PENDAHULUAN

1.1. Latar Belakang

Bidan sebagai tenaga kesehatan strategis yang berada pada garis terdepan dalam pelayanan Kesehatan Ibu dan Anak, Kesehatan Reproduksi Perempuan dan Keluarga Berencana yang tersebar di seluruh penjuru Indonesia. Dengan disahkannya UU Kebidanan ini, menjadi dasar/landasan hukum bagi bidan dalam melaksanakan pelayanan kebidanan yang akan memberikan perlindungan dan kepastian hukum bagi masyarakat dan bidan. Lahirnya UU Kebidanan merupakan peluang dalam pengaturan profesi bidan secara komprehensif mulai dari pendidikan, pelayanan dan pengembangan profesi bidan.

Tuntutan masyarakat akan mutu pelayanan kebidanan semakin meningkat seiring dengan peningkatan pengetahuan dan kemampuan masyarakat maupun perkembangan ilmu pengetahuan dan teknologi di bidang kesehatan terutama kebidanan. Perubahan dan perkembangan tersebut merupakan tantangan untuk meningkatkan kualitas sumberdaya manusia kesehatan.

Paradigma pelayanan kebidanan saat ini telah mengalami pergeseran. Selama satu dekade ini, asuhan kebidanan dilaksanakan dengan mengkombinasikan pelayanan kebidanan konvensional dan komplementer, serta telah menjadi bagian penting dari praktek kebidanan.

Menjadi bidan profesional ada tiga domain yang harus diperhatikan yaitu kemampuan afektif, kognitif, dan psikomotorik. Saat ini kompetensi bidan masih menjadi suatu hal yang harus menjadi perhatian lebih serius. Dengan fokus pada kompetensi, bidan diharapkan mampu memberikan asuhan yang profesional sesuai dengan standar profesi. Hal ini bertujuan untuk membentuk bidan yang profesional, dengan lulusan yang memiliki kompetensi *care provider, communicator, Manager, decision maker* dan *community leader* dan penguasaan substansi kajian kebidanan komplementer. Dalam rangka untuk mendukung kurikulum unggulan program studi dan sesuai dengan profil lulusan bidan, Program Studi Profesi Bidan menyelenggarakan kegiatan ilmiah dalam bentuk kuliah pakar/kuliah umum kebidanan tahun 2024 dengan mengambil tema **“ASUHAN KOMPLEMENTER DALAM PELAYANAN KEBIDANAN”**.

1.2. Tujuan

1.2.1. Tujuan Umum

Mahasiswa Program Studi Sarjana dan Profesi Bidan mampu memahami manajemen pengelolaan pelayanan komplementer bagi *mom and baby* dengan pendekatan pemanfaatan IPTEKS dengan memperhatikan sosial budaya dan sumber daya lokal secara efektif dan efisien di negara ASEAN (Indonesia, Malaysia dan Singapura).

Complementary and Alternative Medicine

World Health Organization defines "complementary and alternative medicine" (CAM) as a "broad set of health care practices that are not part of that country's own tradition and are not integrated into the dominant health care system"

Complementary therapy is usually used in combination with current treatments, and alternative treatments are used instead of current treatments.

Commonly utilized types of CAM include acupuncture, aromatherapy, herbal and homeopathic medicines, meditation, movement therapies, chiropractic and osteopathic manipulation and so on


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In Midwifery

Many women prefer to use CAM during pregnancy because of fewer side effects compared to chemical drugs.

Common types of CAM that are recommended by midwives were:

- Massage therapy
- Herbal medicines
- Relaxation techniques
- Nutritional supplements
- Aromatherapy
- Homeopathy
- Acupuncture



Statistics

Studies have shown that 73% of pregnant mothers in Australia and 83.7% in Mashhad city used CAM during pregnancy.

Today, around the worldwide, midwives use complementary therapies in their profession more than the other medical practitioners.

A literature review estimated that between 65% - 100% of midwives have used one or more complementary therapies.

Another study also showed that 44% of midwifery students had recommended CAM therapies to others.

CAM Methods

One survey in Iran found that CAM methods are prescribed by 37.3% of obstetricians with the most common methods being acupressure, massage and herbal therapy.

These methods can be used for treatment of nausea and vomiting, back pain, anxiety, postpartum depression, anemia, striae gravidarum, insomnia, hemorrhoid, vaginal infection, mal-presentation, augmentation and induction of labor, perineal care, retained placenta and lactation problems

Herbal Therapy in Midwifery

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What is Herbal Therapy?

In midwifery, herbal therapy refers to the use of plants or plant parts to support women's health during pregnancy, childbirth, and postpartum recovery.

It complements traditional midwifery care by offering natural remedies for common discomforts and promoting overall well-being.



Benefits

Pregnancy: Certain herbs can help alleviate common discomforts like morning sickness, heartburn, and constipation. Some may even support relaxation and sleep.

Labor: Herbs can potentially ease pain, enhance uterine contractions, and promote relaxation during labor.

Postpartum: Herbal remedies can aid wound healing, support lactation (breast milk production), and address emotional well-being after childbirth.
